## *Auto Burglaries at Aldea San Miguel*

On Thursday, November 16, 2017 at approximately 0120 hours, The UCSF Police Department was notified that a vehicle's window had been smashed at the Aldea San Miguel parking lot. When Officers arrived they discovered **multiple** vehicles had been burglarized in the surrounding area. A window on each of the vehicles had been smashed by an unknown suspect(s) and vehicle's had been rummaged through. At this time there is no suspect's information.

The UCSF Police Department is currently investigating the auto burglaries and searching for witnesses and suspect information. Anyone with information or have noticed any suspicious activity are encouraged to contact the UCSF Police Department at 415-476-1414. Refer to case #2017-46292.

The UCSF Police Department is also attempting to locate each victim of the auto burglaries. If your vehicle has been burglarized please contact the UCSF Police Department.

### **Auto Burglary Prevention Tips:**

Suspects look for crimes of opportunity and certain personal safety measures can be followed to minimize your chances of becoming a victim. These are:

- Do not leave valuables in your car. Do not leave any trace that there are valuable items in your car.
- If you must leave valuable items in your car, place items out of sight before reaching your destination or move them inconspicuously.
- Try to park in busy, well-lit areas.
- Secure and lock your vehicles.
- Set any alarm or anti-theft device before leaving your vehicle behind.
- Travel in groups whenever possible, especially at night.
- Avoid poorly-lit or deserted areas when walking at night.
- Stay alert to your surroundings. Avoid headphone and cell phone use when walking alone.
