RAD FAQ

Will you be offering more classes?

Yes. Forgive us for the hiatus. We lost several instructors who have moved on to other roles. We have a new team of trainers certified and are excited about teaching this dynamic course to our UCSF community. Our goal is to offer RAD on a regular basis.

How come the class sells out so quickly?

For safety reasons we can only accommodate 20 women in a course at one time. Our team of instructors are committed and dedicated to ensuring that out students have a positive experience and that no one gets injured. That is why we keep the class sizes to a maximum of 20 students.

Can I bring my daughter?

This course is geared towards women 18 years and over. If your daughter is 18 years or older you are welcome to register her.

Can I register my kid?

If your daughter is over 18 years of age, you can register her. There is a RAD KIDS program and you can check the <u>RAD Systems website</u> for more information about this course.

Why is this course only for women?

Research has shown that women are 3 times as likely to be assaulted or attacked in her lifetime. There is a RAD Mens program, please check the <u>RAD Systems website</u> for more information about this course.

Is there a waitlist?

If you are unable to register for a class, not to worry, we will be offering more classes at different locations soon. Please check your email for the announcements. There is a waitlist- follow the instructions on the registration link to add yourself to the waitlist. In the past class participants have dropped out at the last minute, and you will be notified if you are on the waitlist.

When are you going to do a class at SFGH, Laurel Heights, MCB, and Mission Bay?

There are few locations on the various campus locations that are ideal for this course. Our primary location will be at Mission Bay until we can locate other sites that have carpeted or padded flooring and accessible to our students. In addition because of the sensitive subject matter we require a location that can offer our

participants privacy for the entire course. If you know of a location on your campus that you think would be ideal, please email us and let us know!

Will you offer weekend courses?

We have 6 certified instructors that teach RAD. 4 of them are part of our very own UCPD law enforcement and the other 2 instructors work full-time at UCSF. We all volunteer to teach this program because we love it. However we can only schedule classes at times that are as minimally conflict with our primary roles at UCSF. We do hope to offer classes on some weekends in the future, and we are also hoping to get more instructors trained.

Is there a cost for this program?

Yes, the cost is as follows: Students \$15 Staff/faculty \$25 Community members/outside of UCSF \$35

The program costs are for the course materials, and to cover the program overhead.

I'm a UCSF employee; can I do a department recharge?

The registration system that we use is an on-line web-based system that is not set up for department recharge. However, if your department has agreed to pay for your registration you can either ask for a check request, or pay for the course and submit the receipt for reimbursement.
